Candidate motivation

My primary motivation for seeking a role in the Standing Commission is a product of deep rooted commitment to global humanitarian work and a long standing experience in the Red Cross Red Crescent. After nearly forty five years of service to the Red Cross movement first as a youth volunteer in my National Society and as an employee of both the IFRC and at the Kenya Red Cross. Through the institution of the Standing Commission, I believe to be strongly prepared to provide leadership to the Red Cross/Red Crescent movement through my experience as a Secretary General of a national society in a developing country, a delegate various delegations of the IFRC and also as Deputy Secretary General and Director of Operations at the IFRC. In addition, I have served as the Vice President of the IFRC for Africa for a period of four years. For my service, I have been awarded both nationally and internationally including as a recipient of the North-South Prize by the Council of Europe.

In my period of service to the Red Cross/Red Crescent movement, I am known for my commitment to service delivery targeting vulnerable communities around the world through deployment of innovative approaches that fosters partnerships and institutionalises integrity and accountability. I have been a strong proponent of peer to peer support between national societies, which resulted in regional and global initiatives such as the New Partnership for African Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies (NEPARC). In my own national society and under my leadership, we have worked to build a vibrant national society with strong partnerships within the Red Cross/Red Crescent Movement but also with regional and international actors including from the private sector. I have thus developed excellent experience in seeking sustainability of Red Cross/Red Crescent work at national level while deploying global partnerships tools and standards.

As the highest deliberative body for the Movement between Council meetings, the Standing Commission requires experience that is informed by local needs of the Red Cross/Red Crescent operations, while leveraging on the global nature of the Movement. My experience of working at both policy making levels (IFRC and KRCS Governing Boards) and at operational/management roles nationally and globally will be useful for the coordination and cooperation role of the Standing Commission within the Red Cross/Red Crescent Movement.

I am convinced that global landscape, politically, socially and economically is resulting in vulnerabilities that requires a stronger role for the Red Cross/Red Crescent. This role can be enhanced by a Standing Commission that seeks deployment of the distinct mandates of the Movement actors, while utilising the strong a Red Cross/Red Crescent brand and time tested partnerships with our Governments. I believe my experience and commitment will be useful to achieve this. This is the reason why I am motivated to present my candidature for the Standing Commission.
