1. Candidate motivation

Dear members of the Electoral Committee,

I am pleased to submit my candidature for election to the Standing Commission by the 34th International Conference of the Red Cross and Red Crescent to take place in Geneva from 28 to 31 October 2024, duly endorsed by Dr Judith Carvajal de Álvarez, National President of the Colombian Red Cross. I am Juvenal Francisco Moreno Carrillo, and I currently hold the position of National Executive Director of the Colombian Red Cross. It is an honour for me and a responsibility that I will embrace wholeheartedly and with a firm commitment to contribute to the success of this statutory body of the International Conference, of utmost importance to our International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement.

My training as a physician and surgeon at the Pontifical Xaverian University (PUJ) in Colombia and my specialization in hospital management have been the basis for my career in health care and crisis management spanning more than 30 years.
