I am fully aware of the functions assigned to the Standing Commission by Article 18 of the Statutes of the International Red Cross and Red Crescent Movement (the Movement) and that members of the Standing Commission are elected in a personal capacity.

I confirm that I satisfy the requirements, profile and qualifications for candidates established in the Statutes and Rules of Procedure of the Movement as well as in the "Guidelines for Candidates for election to the Standing Commission of the Red Cross and Red Crescent" adopted by the Council of Delegates in 2019 (Resolution 4).

 - not to act in any way that would amount to a perceived, potential or actual conflict of interest.

- b. I must provide full cooperation to the Electoral Committee, in particular with regard to any requests for information and enquiries relating to my candidacy.
- c. all the information that I have submitted, and statements that I have made, in this declaration and in my Nomination Form are truthful and accurate.
- d. I will immediately notify the Electoral Committee if, after the date of signature of this declaration:
 - I am no longer able, for any reason, to fulfil any of the requirements, profile and qualifications applicable to this position, or
 - any of the statements in this declaration or in my Nomination Form, are no longer true or accurate for whatever reason, or
 - there is additional information in relation to this declaration or my Nomination Form.

I understand that any (a) false declaration or statement or omission of relevant information in this declaration or my Nomination Form, (b) failure to notify the Electoral Committee as required above, or (c) failure to fulfil any of the requirements set out in this declaration, may lead to my disqualification as a candidate.

I hereby authorize the Electoral Committee to carry out a background check for purposes of evaluating whether I satisfy the requirements, profile, and qualifications for election to the Standing Commission. I consent to the processing of my personal information as necessary and relevant for these purposes. I understand that the Electoral Committee may engage the services of an external third-party firm(s) for these purposes. Finally, I also understand that I may withhold my permission and that in such case, no background check will be conducted, and my candidature will not be processed.

1. Candidate motivation

I want to emphasize the pivotal role of the Standing Commission as the Trustees and partners of the Movement in safeguarding the integrity, compliance, and adherence to principles and working towards the resolutions set at the Statutory meetings. As a Movement, we have consistently championed inclusion and integrity among our 191 members.

I have had the honor of serving this Movement at every level, bringing 34 years of diverse experience—first as a youth and youth leader, then as a staff member, volunteer, and member, and now as President. As the second president and the first female president of the Grenada Red Cross Society (GRCS), I stepped into leadership during a challenging time when our National Society faced the risk of losing its membership with the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies (IFRC) due to issues such as inadequate reporting, nepotism, and non-compliance.

Through resilience and determination, I worked to restore transparency and respect within our organization, despite limited resources and significant reputational risks. Developing the first constitution for our 40-year-old National Society required courage and a commitment to transforming a culture that had long been entrenched in toxicity.

The development of the GRCS Strategic Plan 2030 and the achievement of our first external audit in nearly 15 years are milestones that reflect our dedication to improvement. I am proud to share that since 2019, the Grenada Red Cross has met its financial obligations to the IFRC on time, without reliance on any Partner National Societies, which has often been the norm to pay arrears to be able to participate in Movement meetings.


My regional and global experiences in guiding task forces and advisory groups have fostered valuable collaborations, enabling us to work more effectively with existing resources. It is imperative that we continue to uphold our fundamental principles, ensuring our services reach those who need them most, while maintaining equity and adhering to established standards.
